Political structure and population:

Argentina is divided into 23 provinces and a federal district (city of Buenos Aires). Capital Federal is an independent city of Buenos Aires.

Population:
37,000,000 habitants
(2001 data).

Official language:

Spanish.

In some places of the country people do speak native languages.

Religion:

In Argentina there is complete freedom of cult. The official religion is Catholicism, professed by the majority of the population. Many people in the country practice other religions such as the Protestantism, the Judaism, the Islam, the Greek Orthodox religion, and Russian Orthodox, amongst others.

Ethnic groups:

About 85% of the Argentinian population comes from European descendants, mainly Spaniard and Italian, although there are a lot of immigrants from Central and Eastern Europe. The remaining 15% is formed by mestizos (mixed group of people of many different types), to a lesser extent, natives and immigrants from the Middle East, mainly from Syria and Lebanon.

Official time:

GMT -3 hours (normal/summer).

National Holidays:

- * **May 25:** First Patriot Government. The First Governing Board independent of the Spaniard Kingdom was constituted.
- * **July 9:** Declaration of Independence from Spain.

Distances from Buenos Aires:


- To San Javier: 650 km
- To Reconquista (Santa Fe): 820 km
- To Añatuya (Santiago del Estero): 950 km

Distances from Airports to Lodges:

- From the Airport of Santiago del Estero to Añatuya: 160 km
- From the Airport of Tucumán to Añatuya: 260 km
- From the Airport of Resistencia (Chaco) to Reconquista: 210 km
- From the Airport of Corrientes to Reconquista: 250 km
- From the Airport of Santa Fe to Reconquista: 330 km
- From the Airport of Santa Fe to San Javier: 160 km

Distances between Lodges:

- San Javier-Añatuya: 450 km
 - 300 km by a combination of road surface and natural roads.



USEFUL DATA

Voltage: 220 volts.

Clothes: if you want to do some laundry, please leave your clothes in front of your door.

Medical Service: if you are not feeling right let our coordinator know it. We will immediately give you a ride to the closest medical institution or to the appropriate health professional.

Complementary activities: if you want to do some alternative activities (City tour, horse riding, if you want to know customs and history of the zone), you should consult itineraries and rates to our coordinator.

Tourism: If you require it, we organize any excursion or travels to Buenos Aires or to the rest of the country. We suggest Iguazú Falls, the Brown Perito Moreno Glacier, Tierra Del Fuego (the southern island of the world, or other parts of Patagonia) as, the northwest (Jujuy and Salta, with the train to clouds).

Currency: Peso Argentino (Argentine Peso). You also can ask our staff to change the money for you.

Tip: They are not compulsory, but people are used to give them, as recognition for the received attention. We suggest U\$S 30/40 for the assistant per day, or its equivalent in Euros €20/25.

For the rest of the personnel, the clients are used to make a contribution altogether, considered in a value similar to the one of the assistant.

HUNTING AREAS

Santa Fe Province CITY OF SAN JAVIER



In the city of San Javier, the Yatay offers the comfort and care that you need to enjoy this trip at its maximum.

Generalities

The city of San Javier is located in the northeast of Santa Fe province, 160 km. from the city of Santa Fe, its capital, and 650 km. from Capital Federal. This region has a subtropical climate. The climate is ideal for the development of agriculture and cattle, its main economic activities. It also has many areas of wetlands and it is located near the Parana river.



Santiago del Estero Province

Generalities


Santiago del Estero is a strategic place because of its cinegetic potential. It combines what a pen hunter wants to find. Ducks, like other aquatic birds, located in inlets which are the result of the overflowing of the Dulce River and the Salado River. This is an excellent habitat for their development.

This zone is characterized by great extensions of sown field of sorghum, soybean, maize, sunflower and wheat, which attracts millions of pigeon and also because of the mounts that posses tons of pigeon.

The area also owns partridges in great proportions. Ducks, partridges, pigeon and doves can be located, and found in only one place.

Big Hunting:

at 210 kilometres from Colonia Dora, a hunting program can be asked. Our organization owns an agreement that complements with a company specialized in this type of hunting.



CITY OF COLONIA DORA

It is located in the intersection of the provincial routes N° 7, and National 34 that joins it with Añatuya -20 km and route N° 7-.

Is the point of convergence of the enormous agricultural explosion of the last times. All the economic activity of the zone turns to agriculture and in a lesser extent around cattle.






The DOVE hunting does not have limits and you can practice it in any moment of the year in all our areas.









The duck has limit and each zone counts on their own limits. Limits are modified every year, according to each area based on climatic conditions.

Please, be respectful of this, and remember that the first limit is determined by the reason of each hunter.

Pigeon: a surprising depth of emotion.

For being a bountiful zone in cultures, that guarantee their food, it causes that this portion of Argentina concentrates the greater wealth in doves in its diverse species. The population of pigeon is increasing each year, reason why nowadays it has become the preferred location by the most demanding hunters. Virgin and exclusive territories generate the additional pleasure to step on a totally native earth.



Doves: the reality surpasses the imagination.

The flight of the doves seems to have no end. In a moment, the hunter feels astonished because it is hard to believe what his eyes are watching at. Simply spectacular, it paralyses and makes you feel excited at the same time. It completes amazement and produces a tremendous admiration.

Ducks: a unique spectacle.

Ducks can be seen in several places. Because of its population and variety, Argentina is a place of a unique spectacle. The region counts with 15 varieties of this aquatic one. The activity begins before they appear with the first rays of the sun. The afternoon will be in charge of offering a similar event. The sunset invites you to return to the Lodge, to regain strengths and to share with friends all your experiences.

The partridge's flight is always electrifying. We count with especially trained Setter dogs. They are the ones in charge to show the piece to you so that you manage to shoot. Soon the dog will reach the result of your accurate firing. It is a fascinating modality of hunting that gets more and more followers.
